## Heritage 100

The Heritage 100, for those who are unaware, is a project which aims to create 100 Heritage walks in County Durham. I have explained the aims and objectives of the Heritage 100 in previous newsletters but our first five walks have been chosen. They will be created in the following areas

- 1.Consett
- 2.Beamish
- 3. Ushaw Moor
- 4. Darlington/Stockton
- 5. Durham City

## Walks Timetable

Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> January 8.00am Consett Tesco - Lakes Walk - Mungrisdale Circuit. Start at Scales by the White Horse Inn CA12 4SY at 10am.

**Sunday 5**<sup>th</sup> **January 9.30am Blanchland** - Meet at the car park at the far end of the village. Looping above the village and then down by the river. A 4 mile walk, a relatively easy start to the year.

**Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> January 9.30am Allensford Loop** - Meet at the car park by the bridge over the A68. 4 mile walk by the Derwent looping around the Derwent Manor Hotel.

Saturday 18th January 8.00am Consett Tesco - Lakes Walk Gowbarrow Fell and Aira Force Loop.

**Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> January 9.30am Ushaw Moor Loop** - Meet at the car park at the bottom of Station Bank by the river on the way to New Brancepeth.

**Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> January 9.30am Beamish Loop** - 3 mile loop around Beamish from Shepherd and Shepherdess skirting around the Museum.
